

KAC (Kalaniana'ole Athletic Club) Girls Basketball
2012 Early Registration

Player and Parents:

The KAC Girls' Basketball League is scheduled to run from approximately March 25 to May 27, 2012. Our enrollment will continue to be on a first come, first served basis and **ratings day (evaluating the girl's skill level) will be mandatory**. The day for ratings will be held on Sunday, February 26, 2012 from 2:30 pm to 4:00 pm at Kilauea Gym. Basketball games are usually played on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays with the hours ranging from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm. Games may be scheduled on Easter Sunday and Mother's Day due to the shortage of gym time. The gyms we have utilized in the past have been Kilauea, Kaimuki District Park, Palolo and Kalani High School. Only two practices are allowed each week with the coach determining his/her practice days and practice court.

Early Registration Procedure:

1. Complete the registration form, which can be down loaded from our web site www.kacbasketball.net. Please indicate if someone is interested in assisting the league (i.e. team parent, coach, etc.) and please **DO NOT MAKE SPECIAL REQUESTS TO BE ASSIGNED TO A SPECIFIC PLAYER/COACH**.

Deadline:

Early registration forms must be postmarked by February 22, 2012. Envelopes post-marked after that date will be returned unopened.

Open Registration:

Players who miss the February 22, 2012 early registration deadline or other players who would like to participate in the KAC Girls' Basketball league may sign up on the Mandatory Rating Day, Sunday, February 26, 2012 at Kilauea Gym. **Please arrive at the appropriate level ratings time listed below. Players should be ready to be rated on that day, dressed in basketball attire and shoes.**

Girls born in the years 1994 through 2006 are eligible to play.

- D. **AGREE THAT ATTENDANCE TO PRACTICES AND GAMES IS MANDATORY.** Chronic absenteeism will result in possible disciplinary action. This action may include, but is not limited to, the reduction of playing time per game, as determined by the Coach and the Level Director.

PARENTS CONTRACT DISCIPLINARY ACTION

All parents **must sign** this contract or will not be able to participate in KAC. This will be the Board's way of having each participant understand the Disciplinary Action set forth by the Board.

Coaches, spectators or players who engage in unsportsmanlike conduct, such as, but not limited to, fighting, abusive language, violent displays of temper or similarly derogatory activity, will be subject to action by the Executive Committee.

- A. The Executive Committee shall have the authority to suspend, discharge or otherwise discipline any player, coach, parent, spectator, umpire, referee or any person whose conduct is considered contradictory and detrimental to the values and best interest of KAC.
1. Persons subject to such discipline shall have the right to a hearing before the Executive Committee before such discipline is imposed.
 1. In the event of disciplinary procedures involving a person under the age of 18, that person's parents are asked to attend the hearing with the individual concerned.
- A. Recognizing the difficulty of establishing specific penalties for a variety of violations of acceptable conduct, the following penalties are suggested. The Executive Committee may impose any which, in its opinion, matches the severity of the offense:
1. **WARNING:** The offending person is to be advised in writing of the offense, and further advised that repetition of the offense will result in a more severe penalty.
 2. **SUSPENSION:** The offending person is to be advised in writing that s/he has been suspended from all league activity for a specific number of days or games.
 3. **DISMISSAL:** The offending person is to be advised in writing that s/he has been dismissed from the league for the remainder of the current year or more.
 4. **BARRED:** The offending person is to be informed in writing that s/he has been barred from present and future participation in the league permanently or for a specific number of years.
